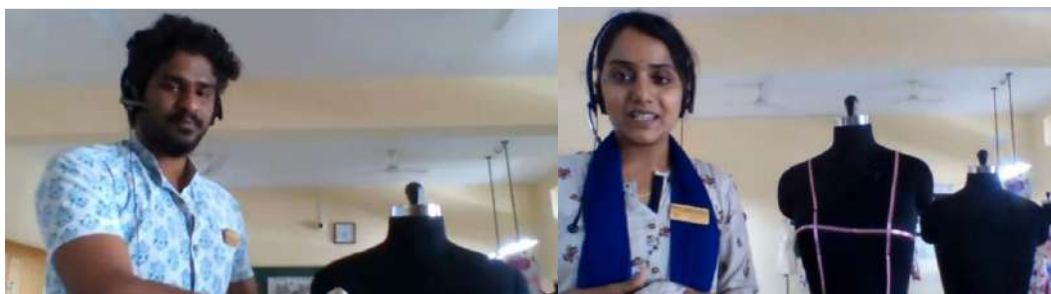

Students Orientation Program AY 2020-21

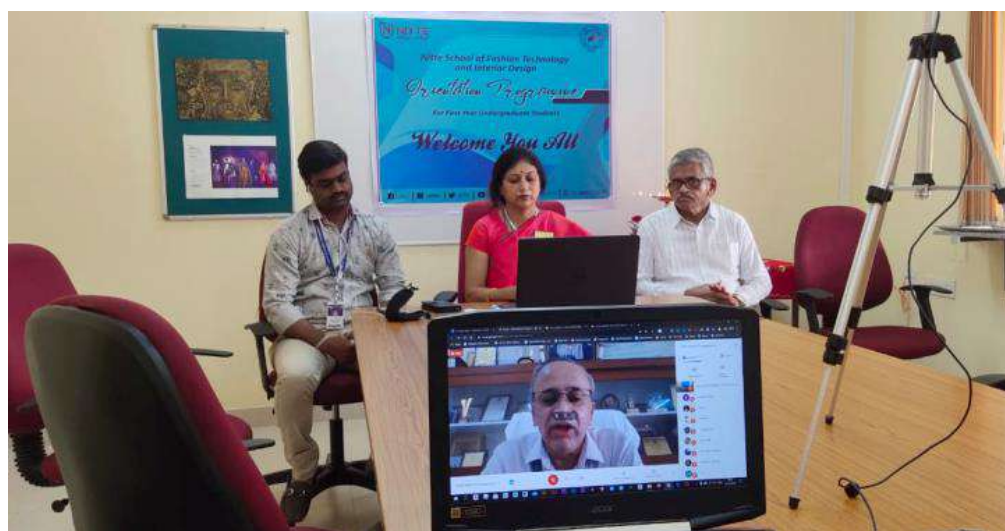

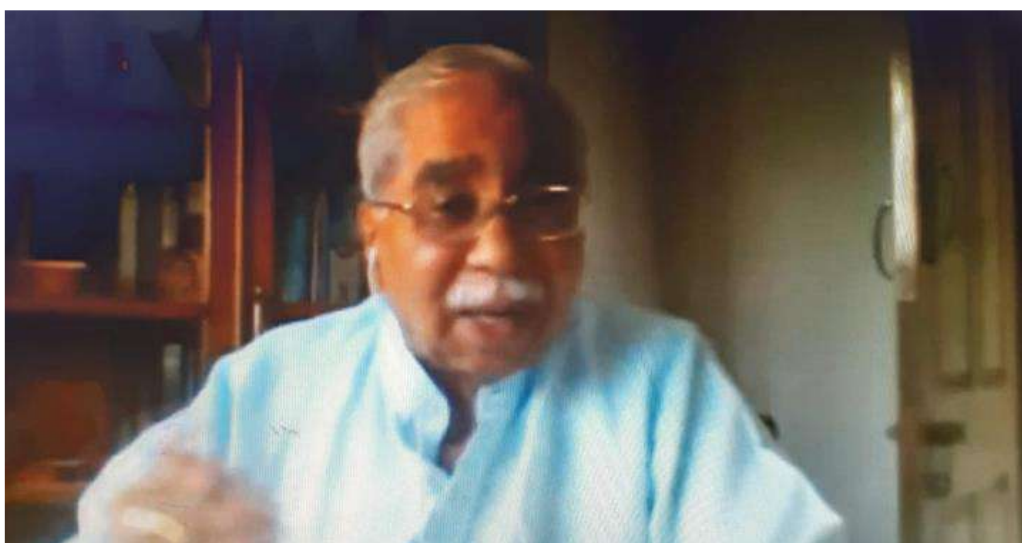
Dr. Chandrashekhara Kambara inaugurated the webinar and spoke on “VACHANA SAHITYA”, In his talk he said that thousands of casts and thousands of gods in India invented priesthood to worship god. Under such circumstances Bhakti Movement awoke and criticized the dependence of man on priest through Vachanas that were advocated by Vachana karas not radically to Literacy production but to spread Vachanas to change assumptions of society in the spiritual practice that was politicized. However, the Literature they promulgated was very influencing. He further said vachanas gave harmony to mankind even in the 21st Century.

Later speaking Prof. N R Shetty said that students of all streams should learn the culture and values of the land they live for moral support in life. Sir also mentioned that in the 12th Century Vachana Literature promoted social equity and brotherhood.
